



## **SOUTH AFRICAN DENTAL TECHNICIANS COUNCIL**

### **Education Inspector Vacancies**

The SADTC is a statutory authority, established in terms of **Section 2 of Act 19 of 1979 (as amended)**, to regulate the profession of Dental Technology in the health sector. Our offices are situated in Arcadia Pretoria. Suitably qualified and experienced persons are invited to apply for the four Dental Technology discipline-specific (*Prosthetics; Cobalt Chrome; Orthodontics and Crown and Bridge*) Education Inspector posts. The term of office shall be three years.

**N.B These appointments are non-salaried positions and only qualifies for a daily honorarium, subsistence allowances and travel costs as applicable to members of the Council and/or committees of Council.**

Applicants for the appointment as Education Inspectors of the S.A. Dental Technicians Council should comply with the following minimum requirements.

1. Must have knowledge and understanding of Act 19 of 1979, as amended, and its associated regulations, specifically pertaining to the education and training of dental technicians and technologists.
2. Must be a registered and practicing dental technologist or dental contractor with more than 10 years of current practical experience in their respective discipline-specific area/s of expertise.
3. Must be CPD compliant.
4. Must not be employed at any of the training institutions involved in the training of dental technicians/technologists or dentists.
5. Must be a graduate from one of the Universities of Technology (UoTs), or previously recognised Technikons, offering the programme for the training of dental technicians/technologists, and has a qualification enabling the applicant to register as a laboratory contractor or owner.
6. Must have sound knowledge of modern dental technology laboratory practice within their respective discipline-specific area of expertise.
7. Must be in good standing with the S.A. Dental Technicians Council.
8. Must be proficient in English in terms of reading, writing and speaking.

**Additional information:**

1. The Education Inspectors of the Council will serve for a probationary period of one year. This is subject to a renewal for a further term not exceeding the term of office of the present Council. At the conclusion of the 3-year appointment, Council may offer a further 3-year extension of the contract.
2. The Education Inspectors must be prepared to serve in an ex officio capacity on the Dental Technology Liaison Committees at the three UoTs.
3. Each Educational Inspector will be a member of the Education Committee of the Council.

**Candidates wishing to apply for the above positions are invited to apply by submitting the following:**

1. A detailed CV.
2. Certified copies of your highest qualifications.
3. A certified copy of your Identity Document.
4. Your TE and/or LA number.
5. Your current SADTC registration invoice.
6. A certified copy of a valid driver's license.
7. Your, current employment details.
8. An acknowledgement that there are no cases pending against you nor that you have been convicted of any crime, either civil or prosecuted by the SADTC must be submitted with the application.
